PARENTS HANDBOOK

- 1) Parents are requested to look into the school diary daily and see that lessons and homework assigned for the next day are done.
- 2) Your child should be encouraged to cultivate habitual cleanliness in all work.
- 3) Giving present to the staff or other demonstrations of gratitude or goodwill in their honour is not allowed.
- 4) Please do not send any gifts or eatables on your ward's birthday, only dry candies/ sweets may be distributed. Only primary students (I TO V) are allowed to wear casual clothes on their birthdays.
- 5) Students who are ill should not be sent to school to attend class or take tests. Once a pupil has come to school, he/she will not be allowed to go home before time.
- 6) Your ward should be instructed to be careful about his/her possessions. There should be a name tag on blazers and sweaters. Expensive articles should not be brought to schools.
- 7) If your ward is absent from school, he/she must make up for all the work missed.
- 8) Inform the school immediately if there is a change of address or telephone number.
- 9) Don't allow your ward to drive to school if he/she does not have a license for the same.
- 10) Parents are requested not to interfere in the internal management of the school to maintain strict discipline. However, suggestions in writing are always welcome by the management.
